Candidates with education credentials earned outside the U.S. must have their credentials evaluated by a member of NACES (www.naces.org), AICE (www.aice-eval.org), or the AACRAO Office of International Education Services (www.aacrao.org). We also accept foreign credential evaluation services approved by another accountancy board. These candidates must meet the requirements listed below.

This form is NOT a substitute for official transcript(s). Your application will not be complete until your official transcript(s) have been received and evaluated by CPA Examination Services.

** 3-quarter hours is equivalent to 2 semester hours

The following requirements must be met within 80 days following the examination. Courses in progress need to be listed on an official Certificate of Enrollment.

1. General college coursework:

- 150 semester (225 quarter) hours – continue to step 2
- 620 on GMAT – continue to step 2

2. Degree:

- Master’s degree in Accounting – you meet the educational requirements
- Master’s degree in Business – complete step 3(a)
- Bachelor’s degree – complete steps 3(a) and 3(b)
- Associate’s degree (must score an 620 on the GMAT) – complete steps 3(a) and 3(b)
