CPA examination applications.

- (A) A CPA examination candidate must complete an examination application approved by the board. All questions on the examination application must be answered and all documents requested must be submitted to ~~the board's administrative agent~~CPAES, defined in paragraph (A) of rule 4701-5-01 of the Administrative Code, before the application will be considered complete. The documentation must verify that the candidate meets the requirements outlined in Chapter 4701-3 of the Administrative Code. All applicable fees must be paid before a candidate can be approved for admission to the examination, unless the applicant qualifies for military assistance.
- (B) The CPA examination will be offered at test centers approved by the board that are administered by ~~the board's authorized examination delivery vendor~~ Prometric, as defined in paragraph (B) of rule 4701-5-01 of the Administrative Code. A list of approved Ohio test centers will be posted on the board's website, ~~and made available upon request unless the applicant qualifies for military assistance.~~
